- Video and Photo can be taken from seats only. Security prohibits spectators from blocking aisles. Spectators are not prohibited to shoot video or photo from anywhere other than your seats. Teams not complying with this rule will be asked to leave and will forfeit the event without refund.
- Spectator admission is \$15. Please have exact change ready in order to prevent lines.

 - **Arrival** - The event takes place in the Kalahari Resort Convention Center. For an event layout visit www.xtremespirit.com/eventinfo.html.
 - **Coach Meeting** - There are no coach meetings at Xtreme Spirit events. If you have questions, please feel free to stop by the Warm-Up Report/Check-In table and ask event staff marked with black Xtreme Spirit polo or staff shirts. If they do not have the answers to your questions, they are instructed to be helpful and try to find the answers for you.
 - **Warm-Up Report/Check-In** - Team Rosters are mandatory for all squads. Participants will be counted on the floor during performance and waivers checked for each participant registered. Please arrive prepared with waivers and/or waiver/team roster filled in with all signatures included. Participants without waivers/rosters turned in will not be allowed to enter warm-up. Warm-up includes 4 minute stations and plenty of time in between so that teams are not rushed - hold, stretch, stunt, tumble, routine, hold, perform. Order of competition will not change for late arrivals. Teams arriving late will not be scored, will not be included in team placements, and are not guaranteed a time to perform.
 - **Warnings** - Tumbling or stunting in any area that cheer floor is not provided will result in disqualification. Unsportsmanlike behavior will lead to deductions and will be highlighted on our website's results page. This will include scolding, yelling, or continued arguments with any Xtreme Spirit staff or other teams throughout the event by owners, directors, coaches, parents, and participants alike. Please do not leave children unattended at any time.
 - **Emergencies** - In the case of a severe injury needing medical attention, please allow building facility staff to notify 911.
 - **Spectators** - Please keep in mind that seating is sometimes limited at Xtreme Spirit events. Please do not save seats or use seats as storage. Bags will be removed as necessary. If your child has performed, please help everyone out by freeing up seats for the next session. Level 2 - 4 divisions will be the most crowded.
 - **Videotaping/Photography** - is allowed FROM DESIGNATED SEATING AREAS ONLY. Professional quality DVD's will be available for order at the event. \$20 DVD's for each session are available to order and receive live at the event. Photos will be displayed for order @ www.anyeventvideo.com a few days after the event.
 - **Awards** - After performing, please exit back into the warm-up area, on Sunday head to Awards rom after your performance. Every participant will receive a trophy that for a few dollars, can be personalized at the engraving booth. Team placement trophies are awarded to all teams. National Champion banners are awarded to all 1st Place teams and pictures will be taken for Xtreme Spirit Magazine. Level Champions are awarded an additional trophy and photo taken again. ELITE International Championship bids are awarded as follows; Gold Bids - 1st Place Bids (100% Registration Paid), Silver Bids - 2nd Place (50% Registration Paid), Bronze Bids - 3rd Place (25% Registration Paid). Paid bids are not refunded.
 - **Score Sheets** - Score sheets and placements will be handed out during the awards presentation. Please review our score and deduction sheets before this event so you are fully prepared for the scores you will receive. They can be downloaded on our rules page @ www.xtremespirit.com. Xtreme Spirit does not review video footage or allow scores to be contested. Up to 3 USASF Safety Judges may be on hand to answer rule infraction questions however; they will most likely be busy scoring the next session after yours. We ask that you please wait until Tuesday following the event to email post event scoring questions and/or video links to marisa@xtremespirit.com. Please do not report deductions from other performances other than your own.
